Entertainers Frankie and Vicki had everyone up dancing including Carol and John who despite being busy in the kitchen still found the time (and energy) to enjoy a dance.

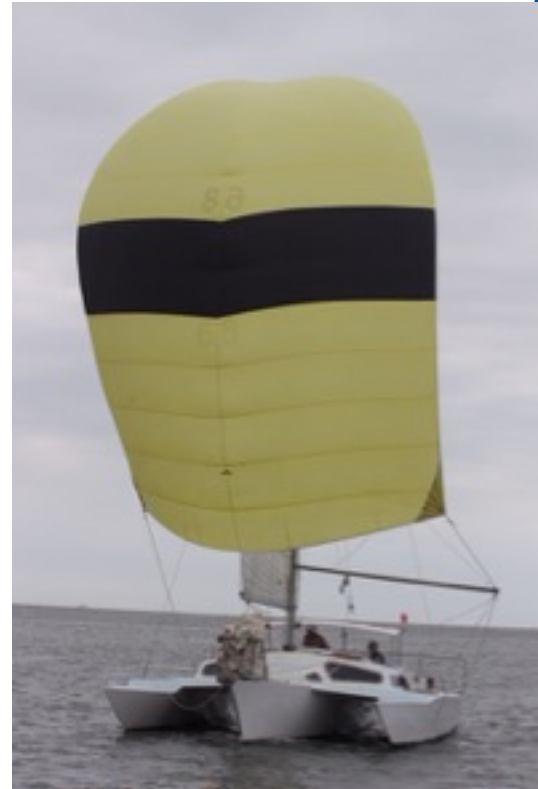
