“Start Sailing” Session This Sunday

Learning to sail a dinghy is a great way to start sailing.

Junior and senior club members wishing to learn the basics of dinghy sailing are welcome to attend *Start Sailing* Sessions that will run regularly on a fortnightly basis throughout the year.

The Tingira Boat Club has six Vagabond dinghies that are fairly stable and simple but still rewarding and challenging to sail.

The course allows participants to learn in a supportive environment and to acquire skills at their own pace. Rather than a course with a rigid set time length, the course is cyclical in nature with topics being re-visited at various times during the year.

This allows participants to catch up on any topics they may have missed out due to illness, holidays or work commitments.

Participants will receive a folder containing information sheets and a competency list.

Once a particular skill or element is demonstrated (e.g. tying a bowline knot) it is signed off by one of our club’s experienced sailors.

Once all the listed skills are demonstrated the participant will receive a course completion certificate from the Tingira Boat Club.

10.30-10.45 am - Assemble at muster point, 27°38.027 S, 153°22.380 E, (Near the blue 'Police' mooring buoy, between the Lamb Island Jetty and Karragarra Island.)

11.00 am - Commence Sail Past. Paddle, row, sail or motor in line astern, following the Water Police vessel, to Red (Port) marker off Karragarra Beach, then anchor up once past the marker, ensuring you are out of the channel and away from barges and ferries, then proceed to the beach.

12.00 Noon - Assemble on the beach for formal Blessing of the Fleet by Alan Early, CPO Royal Aust. Navy Band (Retired).

12.30 pm - Ham and salad \$10.00 (Must be pre-ordered and paid by Monday, 5 March). Soft drinks \$2.00 and bottled water \$1.00 will be available on the day, and also free tea and coffee.

We will be having a couple of small raffles and may also have a small range of KYC merchandise for sale.
