The course for the proposed sailing events will be similar to that used for the Calvert Memorial Sailing Event held in October.

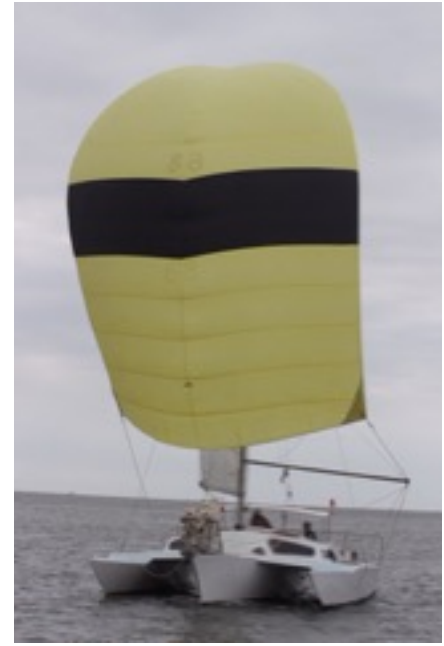
Each event will have separate awards but we intend having an overall series winner using the best three results out of the four.
