## **Tingira Big Boat Sailing Series - This Sunday 25 March**

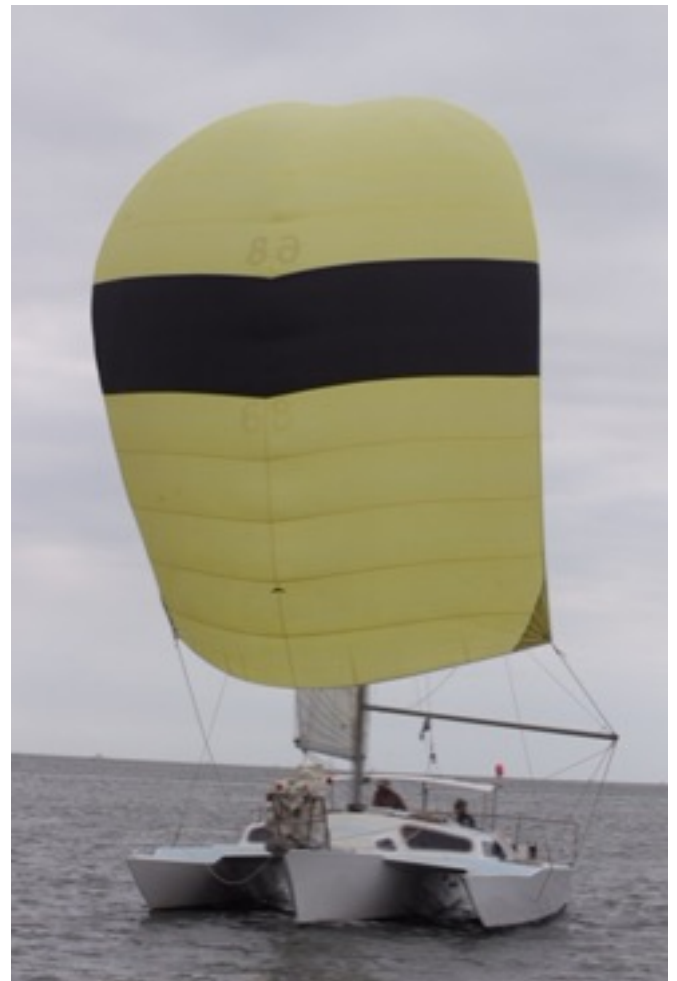
The first event of the proposed Tingira Big Boat Sailing Series will take place this Sunday 25 March. Starting time - 11:00am.

The aim of the session is to familiarise volunteers with the operation of our two safety boats and the location of the necessary equipment (fuel, keys, buoys etc). The session will be led by Peter Lawson & Laurie O'Toole. This session will be the first of several to be held over the coming months to assist in developing expertise amongst our volunteers in the operation of our safety boats.



### You will need to bring:

- Clothing suitable for boating and the predicted weather (you will most likely get wet during launching and retrieval process).
- Sun protection (e.g. hats, sunscreen, sun shirt and sun glasses)
- Some lunch or a snack
- Life jacket (life jackets are available at the Club)
- Boat shoes (optional)
