Disposal of Club's Kitchen Refrigerator and Freezer

Recently the Club purchased a new six door refrigerator to replace two existing refrigerators and an upright freezer located in our Club's kitchen.

After careful consideration the Management Committee has made the decision to retain one of the existing fridges but dispose the other refrigerator and the upright freezer through a secret tender process that will be only open to members of the Club.

Members are invited to submit a secret tender for the following items:

- **1 x Fisher & Paykel 450L refrigerator (white)**
- **1 x Fisher & Paykel 450L upright freezer (white)**

Offers should be submitted in a sealed envelope addressed to **The Secretary, Tingira Boat Club Inc.** and include: The member's name; the item being tendered for and the value of their bid.

The sealed envelope should be posted in the Club's locked letterbox at 91 Coast Road Macleay Island or handed directly to Club Secretary, Peter Fox.

Tenders open from **Tuesday 27 March** and will close at **3:00pm on Friday 13 April 2018.**

Both the refrigerator and the upright freezer can be inspected during the following times:
Sunday On The Deck (Sunday 01 April & Sunday 08 April).

Friday Fish and Chips Dinner (Friday 06 April).

Please note that both the refrigerator and the freezer were in good condition and working well up to the time that they were replaced.

The sealed tenders will be opened by the Secretary and club member David Dunk to ascertain the highest bid for each item.

The winning bids will be announced at the Friday members dinner on Friday 13 April. The successful members are expected then to pay for and collect their purchase in a timely manner.

This 30' (9.20 metre) MASRM sloop is perfect for the bay. It has a hydraulic retractable keel, furling jib, and provision for a spinnaker. The main can be double or single reefed if required and a whisker pole is on board. It is powered by a 4-stroke 20hp Suzuki electronic outboard motor fixed to the stern. Currently moored off Karragarra Island, the mooring comes with the boat if required.

Two batteries, small solar panel for battery charging, all lights working inside and out.

Inside, there are six sleeping berths, a shower recess with hand basin, a separate toilet with holding tank. Fresh water tank is under the forward V berth. The galley has a sink, gas stove and oven on gimbles and enough cupboards for everything you need.

Other items: compass, gas bottle, fenders, maps, flares, kitchen equipment, 2 boathooks, lifejackets, Beacon to Beacon book and other items.

Just been antifouled and the deck painted.
