Or the skip would kick my rumdy, dumdy day.

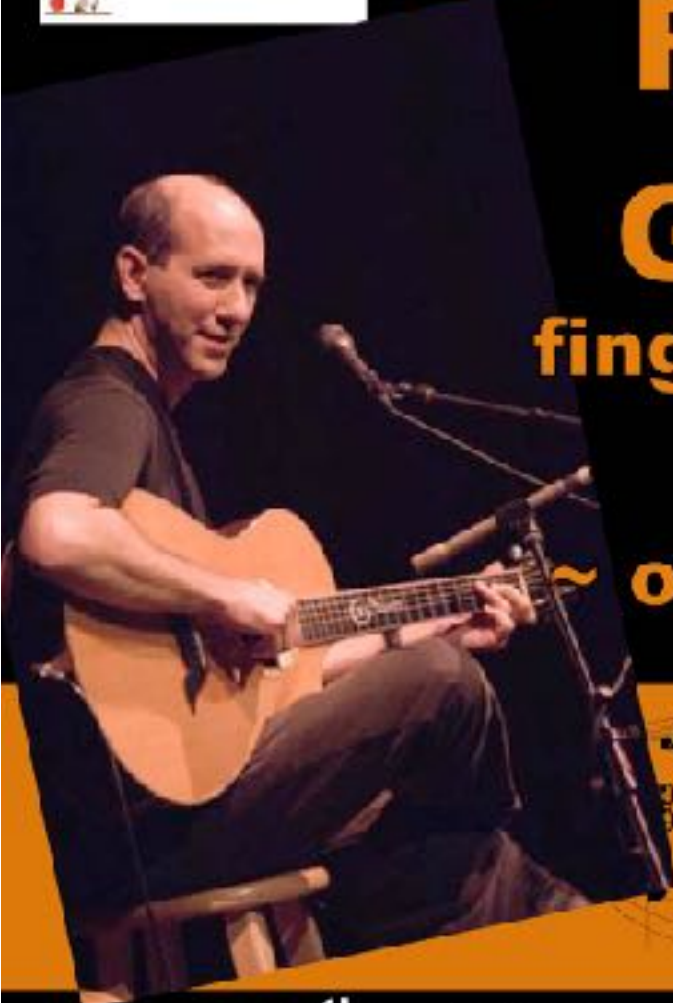
