Matthew Flinders' Day on Coochiemudlo Island - Sunday 15 July

In past years the Tingira Boat Club has supported this commemorative event with members taking their boats (power or sail) to join in the festivities on Coochiemudlo Island.

This year there is a high tide of 1.97m at 11:35am (Potts Point) and so we are planning to sail the Vagabonds and paddle the outrigger canoes (weather permitting) over to Coochiemudlo Island. Members of the **Wooden Boat Association of Queensland** are also planning on joining in and other Tingira members are encouraged to join the fleet (aka the Tingira Armada) in their own private motor or sail boats.

The Tingira Armada Combined Start: It would be good to have all boats starting in mass so a combined start of sail, power and paddle boats from the Club Pontoon is scheduled for about 10:00am (approx). Our two safety boats **Tango** and **Sandpiper** will accompany the Armada over to Coochiemudlo.

Read more about Matthew Flinders' Day

This annual event is staged by the Coochiemudlo Progress Association and commemorates the exploration of Moreton Bay in July 1799 by Matthew Flinders in the sloop *Norfolk*. On 19 July 1799 Flinders landed on Coochiemudlo Island which he referred to as the Sixth Island. He also visited Bribie Island and the Pumicestone Passage

The festivities on Coochie feature a market from 9am - 2pm in Foreshore Park which includes art, craft, brick a brac and food stalls.

Also on Sunday morning there will be a street parade commencing at 10:00am led by the Redlands Ladies Drum Corps and will also include the Navy Cadets and other Island groups & organisations.

The Matthew Flinders landing re-enactment will take place on the Main Beach beside the market with Matthew Flinders being rowed ashore in "*Trim*" at about 11:45am.

So a trip over to Coochie would be well worth it with lots to see and do!
