Tingira Dragon Boats / Outrigger Canoes Session Times

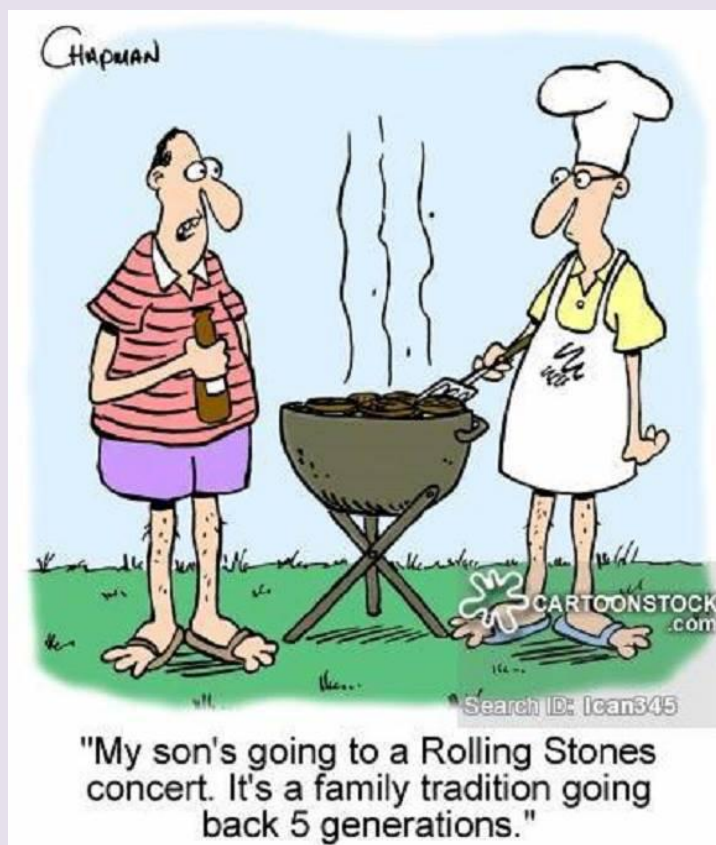
The Dragon Boat or Outrigger Canoe sessions scheduled for the week are as follows:

Event 1 of the Calvert Sailing Series This Sunday

The first event of the Calvert Memorial Sailing Series is scheduled for this Sunday 05 May with a starting time of **11:00am** (approximately).

The event will be sailed over the traditional triangular course set between Macleay and Peel Islands. The start and finish line will be located between the committee boat (club pontoon) and an orange buoy adjacent to the Dalpura Anchorage which is located on the north western side of Macleay Island.

The other events are scheduled to take place on :

Event 2 - Sunday 07 July (or alternatively 21 July);

Event 3 - Sunday 13 October (or alternatively 20 October)

(Please note:- The alternate dates are included in case any of the scheduled events are cancelled due to the weather being unsuitable e.g. strong wind warning.)

Sailing instructions, course maps and nomination forms for the event have been emailed out to all members and can also be downloaded from our website tingiraboatclub.com by clicking on the Calvert Memorial Sailing Series link.

Each event will have separate awards but there will be an overall series winner and placegetters using the cumulative results of the three events. **The Calvert Memorial Trophy** will be awarded to the yacht placed first on handicap for the overall series.

Awards for the events will be presented at the Calvert Memorial Dinner planned for **Saturday 26 October**. On this night it is planned to have a combined awards night for the yacht, off-the-beach sailing and paddling divisions.

This 30' (9.20 metre) MASRM sloop is perfect for the bay. It has a hydraulic retractable keel, furling jib, and provision for a spinnaker. The main can be double or single reefed if required and a whisker pole is on board. It is powered by a 4-stroke 20hp Suzuki electronic outboard motor fixed to the stern. Currently moored off Karragarra Island, the mooring comes with the boat if required.

Two batteries, small solar panel for battery charging, all lights working inside and out.

Inside, there are six sleeping berths, a shower recess with hand basin, a separate toilet with holding tank. Fresh water tank is under the forward V berth. The galley has a sink, gas stove and oven on gimbles and enough cupboards for everything you need.

Other items: compass, gas bottle, fenders, maps, kitchen equipment, 2 boathooks, lifejackets, Beacon to Beacon book and other items.
