Sailing Roundup - Sunday 19 May

The final races of the Off-the-Beach Summer Sailing Series were conducted on Sunday.

An early high tide meant an early start to the races and so there was only time for a short *Start Sailing* theory session.

We welcomed **Debbie and John Phillips** to our sailing group and had them practising tying some useful sailing knots.

We then went outdoors and demonstrated the procedure to rig the Vagabonds while introducing the names of the ropes, sails and other equipment.

Once the rigging was completed it was time for a briefing and then set sail for our scheduled races.

Five crews nominated for the morning races:

Peter Deane and Debbie Phillips in *Vagabond 4* (Scratch placings 1st, 2nd, 3rd / Handicap placings 1st, 2nd, 3rd)

Peter Fox and Sho Fujimoto in *Vagabond 2* (Scratch placings 2nd, 1st, 1st / Handicap placings 2nd, 1st, 1st)

Peter Lawson, Troy and Xavier Gow in *Vagabond 3* (Scratch placings 4th, 4th, DNS / Handicap placings 4th, 4th, DNS)

Ian Wilkinson and Sue Peterson in *Vagabond 6* (Scratch placings 3rd, 3rd, 2nd / Handicap placings 3rd, 3rd, 2nd)

and Bruce Legg and Rani Stainton in *Leggo* (DNF, DNS, DNS)

Our sailors were greeted with a coolish SSE breeze with intermittent squalls and lulls. Crews needed to be on their toes to keep their boats upright by easing the sheets to counter the sometimes sudden stronger puffs of breeze. Skippers also needed to be wary of the wind shifts so that they could take advantage of the lifts or headers that accompanied each squall.

Out on the Tingira Pontoon **Dudley Kavanagh, Ray Ward and Neville**

Prosser did an excellent job in starting, finishing and recording the three races.

Ivan Scott and **Brendan Edmonds** crewed the Club safety boat "Sandpiper" and were kept busy during the morning.

The southerly breeze meant that the boats tacked upwind for the first leg from the start line toward the Garden Island Passage red beacon. Once rounding the red beacon to starboard, the fleet sailed downwind toward the northern rounding buoy (near Iron Stem green beacon). Sailing downwind in the prevailing conditions had to be done cautiously with the wind changes making an accidental gybe quite a possibility. On rounding the southern mark it was then a short windward work back to the Pontoon start/finish line.

The races were quite demanding and not entirely incident free.

In the first race **Leggo** (Bruce and Rani) got away well from the start and led the way to the top mark (Garden Island Passage red beacon). On approaching the rounding mark, Bruce encountered a stronger puff of breeze and a header and unfortunately went for a swim. Ivan and Brendan stood by in **Sandpiper** to give aid if necessary.

Debbie Phillips sailing with Peter Deane had her first introduction to sail boat racing and capsizing, taking a quick dip in the water during the third leg of the last race. Peter sailed his Vagabond close to the shore to avoid the oncoming tidal current but unfortunately found the muddy bottom. This caused a capsize but both Peter and Debbie made a very quick recovery and managed to finish the race only a minute or two behind the others.

All in all it was a very successful and interesting conclusion to the Summer Sailing Series.
