**NOTICE OF RACE**

**1. RULES**

The regatta will be governed by the current rules as defined in 2017 - 2020 World Sailing (ISAF) *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the rules and racing rules of the Jubilee Class, (except as any of these are altered by the sailing instructions) and by the sailing instructions.

**2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 2.1** The regatta is open to all boats of the Jubilee Class.
- 2.2** Entries will be received from eligible boats on the attached Nomination Form and payment of the required fee. **Entries must be lodged no later than 5:00pm on Friday 10 April 2020** Email address for Entries: [admin@tingiraboatclub.com](mailto:admin@tingiraboatclub.com)
- 2.3** Any alteration to the submitted crew list to be lodged at the Tingira Boat Club prior to start time.

**3. REQUIRED FEES**

**4. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS**

The race times scheduled below are approximate. It is intended to commence following races 10 minutes after the finish of the last boat in the previous race.

**Saturday 11 April 2020**

- 9:00am Welcome and Briefing
- 10:30am Race 1 (Time of first Warning Signal)
- 11:30am (approx) Race 2 (Time of first Warning Signal)
- 12:30pm (approx) Race 3 (Time of first Warning Signal)
- 1:30pm (approx) Completion of racing. BBQ lunch at the Tingira Clubhouse.
- 7:00pm Dinner at the Macleay Island Bowls Club (for those wishing to attend).

**Sunday 12 April 2020**

- 11:30am (approx) Race 4 (Time of first Warning Signal)
- 12:30pm (approx) Race 5 (Time of first Warning Signal)
- 1:30pm (approx) Race 6 (Time of first Warning Signal)
- 2:30pm (approx) Completion of racing. BBQ and refreshments at the Tingira Clubhouse.
- Presentation of trophies approximately 1 hour after the completion of the last race.

**5. MEASUREMENT**

Measurement is not required. Boats may be inspected at any time during the regatta, and any boat found not to measure may be subject to disqualification after a hearing.

**6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The sailing instructions will be available from the Tingira Boat Club website ([tingiraboatclub.com](http://tingiraboatclub.com)) or may be collected from the Clubhouse on Saturday 11 April prior to the event briefing.

## **7. REGATTA SITE & RACING AREA**

The regatta site will be on the waters of the western side of Macleay Island.

The racing areas will be designated areas west and north of Dalpura Bay, Macleay Island.

## **8. COURSES**

The courses shall be windward and return ('sausage' courses), as described in the sailing instructions.

## **9. PENALTY SYSTEM**

Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turn Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

## **10. SCORING**

**10.1** Scores will be based on the accumulative scratch placings for each race and use the low score system (1st place = 1 Point). Boats that do not start, finish, retire or are disqualified are scored one more point than the total entrants of the series.

**10.2** Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

**10.3** When fewer than five races have been sailed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

**10.4** When five (or more) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

## **11. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS**

**11.1** A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio or electronic communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones and GPS.

**11.2** It is highly recommended that each competing boat be equipped with a VHF handheld radio operating on channel 77 and/or a mobile telephone. A handheld radio maybe available on request from the Tingira Boat Club.

## **12. PRIZES**

**12.1** *The Queensland Jubilee Championship Perpetual Trophy (Before the Wind)* will be awarded for the boat that gains the least number of points in the series.

**12.2** Individual prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places overall.

**12.3** *"The Pump"* trophy will be awarded to the wooden boat that gains the least number of points in the series.

**12.4** The *"Female Skipper Trophy"* will be awarded to the female skipper gaining the least number of points in the series.

**12.5** Trophies will be presented by the Tingira Boat Club on Sunday 12 April approximately 1 hour after the conclusion of the last race.
