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Queensland Check in App

The Queensland Government has made it mandatory that all pubs, clubs, restaurants and cafes in Queensland change to the Queensland Check-In App to allow attendees to register their presence electronically.

The Tingira Boat Club will switch to this form of QR recording as from Friday April 16, 2021.

All you need to do is:

- ✓ Download Queensland Check-In app from Google Play or Apple App stores
- ✓ enter your details once when you first open the app
- ✓ open the app when you next visit us
- ✓ select 'Check-in Now' and scan or enter our code

You only have to ever enter your details once.

You can use it at any venue using the Queensland Check-In App.

If you do not have a suitable smart phone, you can still enter your details on the sheets available which will be added electronically by staff later.

Using this digital check in means your details will be stored securely by the Queensland Government for 56 days to assist with COVID-19 contact tracing (if needed).

The Check-In Qld app is safe, secure and private. By using it, you are helping Queensland's pubs, clubs, restaurants and cafes to stay open, and you can visit us with confidence, knowing you can be contacted quickly and easily if there is any risk of exposure to the virus.

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Start Sailing Course - Sunday 11 April

An early start did not deter six enthusiastic beginning sailors from attending Session 9 of our Tingira *Start Sailing Course*.

Correspondingly there was a very pleasing number of experienced sailors in attendance to share their sailing experience and knowledge with our newbie sailors.

The day started with a theory session revising the steps involved in rigging a Vagabond dinghy. We had a look at the rigging checklist that has recently been developed (it was Bells Mason's idea). We then revised the Heave To procedure (or how to stop the boat).

Next it was outdoors to rig up the Vagabonds. Bells Mason and Julie Knutsen demonstrated that they could successfully rig their Vagabond without the assistance of an instructor.

Congratulations to them both.

Meanwhile Michael, Kim and Jenny went through the rigging process with assistance from an experienced sailor.

They will no doubt be rigging their boat unassisted in the next couple of sessions.

The Vagabonds were then launched and it was time to put into practice our Heave To manoeuvre and helming the boat on a set sausage shaped course.

With a light WSW breeze and bright sunshine, it was a pleasure to be out on the water.

The safety boat crew Bob Stampton and Digby Huffam did a great job of laying the buoys for the course and keeping an eye on the Vagabonds.

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Next Sunday the *Start Sailing* session will commence at 11:00am with a theory session on how to avoid a capsize, and how to recover from one when it does happen. This will be followed by a practical session on the water where the capsize recovery will be demonstrated by our instructors close inshore (water will be shallow enough to allow participants to stand). Clothes and hats or caps suitable for bathing will be required. Reef walkers or aqua shoes would also be handy if you have some to wear to protect your feet. Afterwards if time allows, we will head out on the water for some more practice helming the boat.

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OC6 OUTRIGGER CANOEING

Hi All,

We will be dividing our sessions up so all paddlers whether NEW/ CASUAL or ADVANCED get the maximum or minimum time on the water possible.

As we enter the cooler months, tide heights become smaller during the day so time becomes limited.

So please be on time which is 10 minutes early.

We will have an ADVANCED SESSION followed by shorter easier paddle for NEW and CASUAL PADDLERS.

The ADVANCED PADDLING session will go for 2 hrs maximum.

Once back at the club any NEW or CASUAL PADDLERS will be taken out for a paddle.

Any NEW members or guests are welcome to come for a CASUAL PADDLE which is a short fun paddle along the coast usually with a swim stop if interested. You will learn the basic fundamentals of paddling and safety.

NEW or CASUAL paddlers should be reasonably fit. Bring a water bottle, hat, sunnies if you want, towel and light clothing.

ADVANCED PADDLING is for those who are fit, have paddled before or can and have paddled at least non-stop around the island - 14k and also completed a huli (flip training) session and know the basic fundamentals and safety rules of paddling.
