Mirror Dinghy Restoration Project

Day 7 09/06/2021

Work continued on the Mirror Dinghy last Wednesday. We were very pleased with how the undercoat had dried during the week and is now ready to be sanded or faired before the top coats are applied. More sanding was needed inside the hull, especially on the cockpit floor which has (soon to be had) a very tough hard to remove grungy enamel / latex paint coating. (But we are getting rid of it - bit by bit)

Then came the very satisfying task of applying fresh varnish to the bare wood of the interior. We chose to use Feast Watson Spar Marine varnish.

Bruce and Trevor thinned the first coat with some turpentine to allow the varnish to penetrate easily into the dry (and thirsty wood). After giving the inside of the hull a coat of varnish we had a break for coffee (and cake) up on the deck to give the first coat some time to go touch dry. We followed with a second coat and still the varnish disappeared into the thirsty wood. A follow-up 3rd coat was applied on Sunday morning and it is now starting to look just like a wooden Mirror dinghy should look - gleaming and beautiful!

This Wednesday 16 June we are meeting at the Clubhouse at 12 noon for a BYO pie (or sausage roll) lunch on the deck and then go to work lightly sanding/fairing the varnish inside the hull ready for some more coats of varnish. We will also sand back the spars (mast, boom and gaff), rudder and centre board before giving them some fresh coats of varnish as well.

Anyone or everyone (spectators, workers, experts, novices, advisors, hecklers etc) are very welcome to join in or take a look at this restoration project in progress.

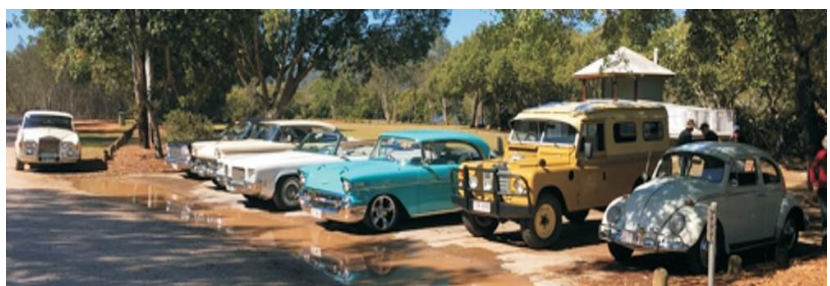

Queensland Check in App

The Queensland Government has made it mandatory that all pubs, clubs, restaurants and cafes in Queensland change to the Queensland Check-In App to allow attendees to register their presence electronically.

The Tingira Boat Club will switch to this form of QR recording as from Friday April 16, 2021.

All you need to do is:

- ✓ Download Queensland Check-In app from Google Play or Apple App stores
- ✓ enter your details once when you first open the app
- ✓ open the app when you next visit us
- ✓ select 'Check-in Now' and scan or enter our code

You only have to ever enter your details once.

You can use it at any venue using the Queensland Check-In App.

If you do not have a suitable smart phone, you can still enter your details on the sheets available which will be added electronically by staff later.

Using this digital check in means your details will be stored securely by the Queensland Government for 56 days to assist with COVID-19 contact tracing (if needed).

The Check-In Qld app is safe, secure and private. By using it, you are helping Queensland's pubs, clubs, restaurants and cafes to stay open, and you can visit us with confidence, knowing you can be contacted quickly and easily if there is any risk of exposure to the virus.
