Trip to the Carrington Boating Club

A group of Tingira members paid a visit to the Carrington Boating Club in Corinda last Saturday for the annual Carrington Regatta.

Although there was a big westerly breeze blowing there was plenty of sunshine to make it a very pleasant trip.

There was an interesting display of boats - some floating, some on trailers and one on a slipway.

***Maiwar* (The indigenous name for the Brisbane River)**

One very interesting boat on display was an ocean rowboat that was nearing completion and ready to be launched from the slipway that afternoon.

The boat was designed and built by 22 year old Tom Robinson who has completed an apprenticeship in marine craft construction.

Tom dreams of becoming the youngest person to row across the Pacific Ocean, rowing solo from Chile, South America, to Brisbane.

Tom expects *Maiwar* to be fully completed by October and then shipped over to Chile.

He plans to commence his rowing journey early next year, travelling via Tahiti, the Cook Islands, Tonga and then back home to Brisbane.

His notion of an epic rowing adventure began at an early age. At only 14 years of age, Tom rowed a converted OK Dinghy sailboat from Chelmer (Brisbane River) to the Gold Coast, sleeping in the boat at nights. It will be interesting keeping up to date with Tom and his epic adventure.
