At 4.00pm on Sunday August 8, 2021, the Queensland Government announced that the Lock Down on South East Queensland would cease, however some restrictions would be in place. These will be in place for the next two weeks.

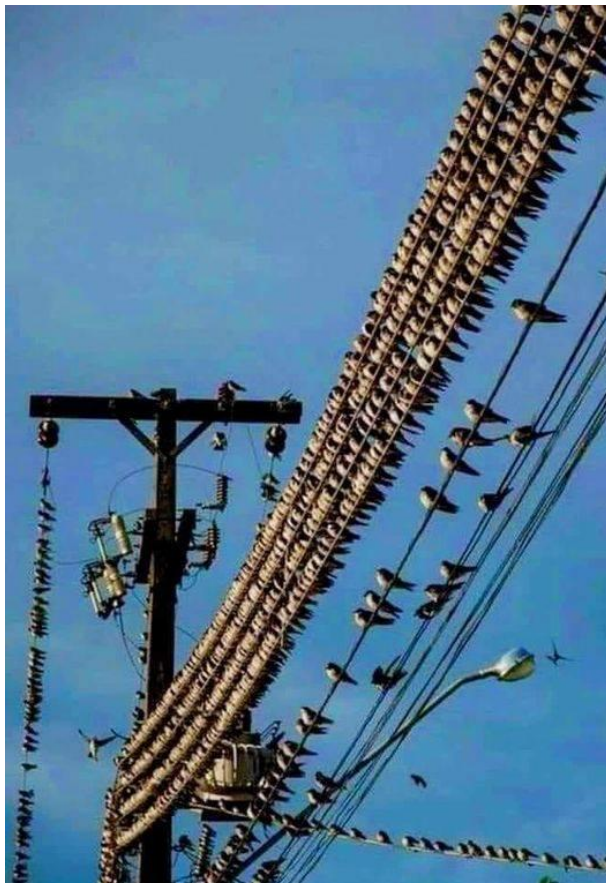
