## 2nd Queensland Jubilee Championships

The Tingira Boat Club will host the 2nd Queensland Championships for Jubilee One-Design Class Yachts on Saturday 11 and Sunday 12 September 2021.

Sailing Master Ian Waller-Wilkinson and his sailing sub-committee have been busy planning for this special event.

There are expected to be up to nine Jubilees participating in the regatta. Each boat will have a crew of two or three.

The regatta will take place on the western side of Macleay Island and be quite visible from the Clubhouse. The regatta will consist of a series of three races on Saturday and three races on Sunday.

All races will start and finish at the Club pontoon *Tingira*.

Moss Lane, Bob Stampton, Don Noble, Marion Mori, Michael Larsen and Dudley Kavanagh have volunteered to be the race officials and be responsible for starting and finishing the races and recording the results. Keeping an eye on the safety of the sailors will be our two safety boats *Sandpiper* and *Tango*. Safety crews rostered for the weekend are Peter Lawson, Kerry Otter, John Hardy and Norm Black.

Helping out with communications will be Barry Jamieson and Ruth Venner, who will operate the Tingira land-base VHF radio and mobile phone calls while Moss Lane will be monitoring the VHF radio and mobile phone calls on the pontoon.

Following the races on both days, food and refreshments will be available for the sailors and officials at the Clubhouse. A number of the sailors will be travelling from the mainland and our Club bus will be made available to pick-up and return our visitors to the Macleay Island jetty.

On Sunday afternoon, the regatta will conclude with a presentation of trophies and prizes to the winning crews. Other awards include a trophy for the wooden boat with the fastest times. I am sure that the sailors will stay on afterwards to enjoy some Tingira hospitality.
