Hire of Boat Club facilities for a Private Function

A benefit of Club membership is that members (with at least 3 months standing) have the opportunity of hiring the Boat Club for a private function.

The Club has a policy of only hiring our facilities to members and community groups (e.g. Macleay Island State School).

The hire of the Club facilities can include the use of the kitchen, bar, tablecloths, plates, cutlery and sound equipment

Following are some of the conditions and requirements of hiring the Club:

- The hirer must be a Club member of at least 3 months standing.
- The application to hire the Club must be lodged with the secretary at least one month prior to the function.
- The function must be approved by the Management Committee.
- At least one Committee member must be present at the function.
- No liquor can be brought onto the Club premises and the Club licensing hours, areas and regulations must be observed.
- Functions cannot exceed 5 hours

Charges for the Club hire:

- Set hire fee (includes use of the kitchen) is \$200.
- If the bar is required it is an additional \$100 but includes two bar volunteers.
- There is a refundable cleaning bond of \$200 which is reimbursed if the Club is left in a clean and tidy condition.

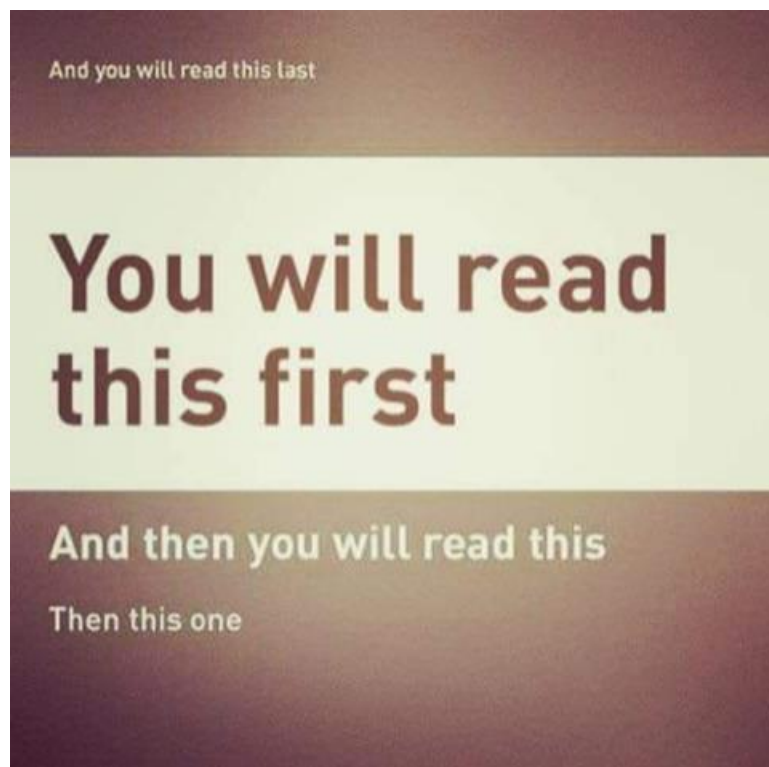
