Commodore Moss - Off to a Big Bush Bash

This week Commodore Moss Lane will be 'hitting the road' and participating in the **Great Endeavour Rally - 2021 Simpson Desert Adventure**.

Moss will depart the Island early this Wednesday morning to embark on his great outback road adventure. He will not be returning to the Island until the 16th October.

The rally starts in St George with the participants travelling on roads and tracks very few have driven, including the Strezlechi Track, Walkers Crossing, Warburton and Birdsville Tracks. They will visit outback places such as Tibooburra, Cameron's Corner, Poeppel Corner and Birdsville. The rally route will take them through outback Queensland all the way to the Northern Territory border (Poeppel Corner) before looping back to finish at Charleville.

The Great Endeavour Rally has now been taking place for 33 years and is one of Australia's longest and most successful charity motoring events.

The Rally not only raises money for people with disabilities but injects money into the outback towns and schools they visit along the way. Imagine the interest (and money) that this year's rally will bring when 70 car teams and 20 officials roll into these remote towns.

Over the 9 years of his involvement, Moss (aka Team Popeye) has raised approximately \$45 000 dollars for this worthy charity.

This year will mark 10 years of Moss's involvement in the event, however this time he will be participating as one of the rally officials.

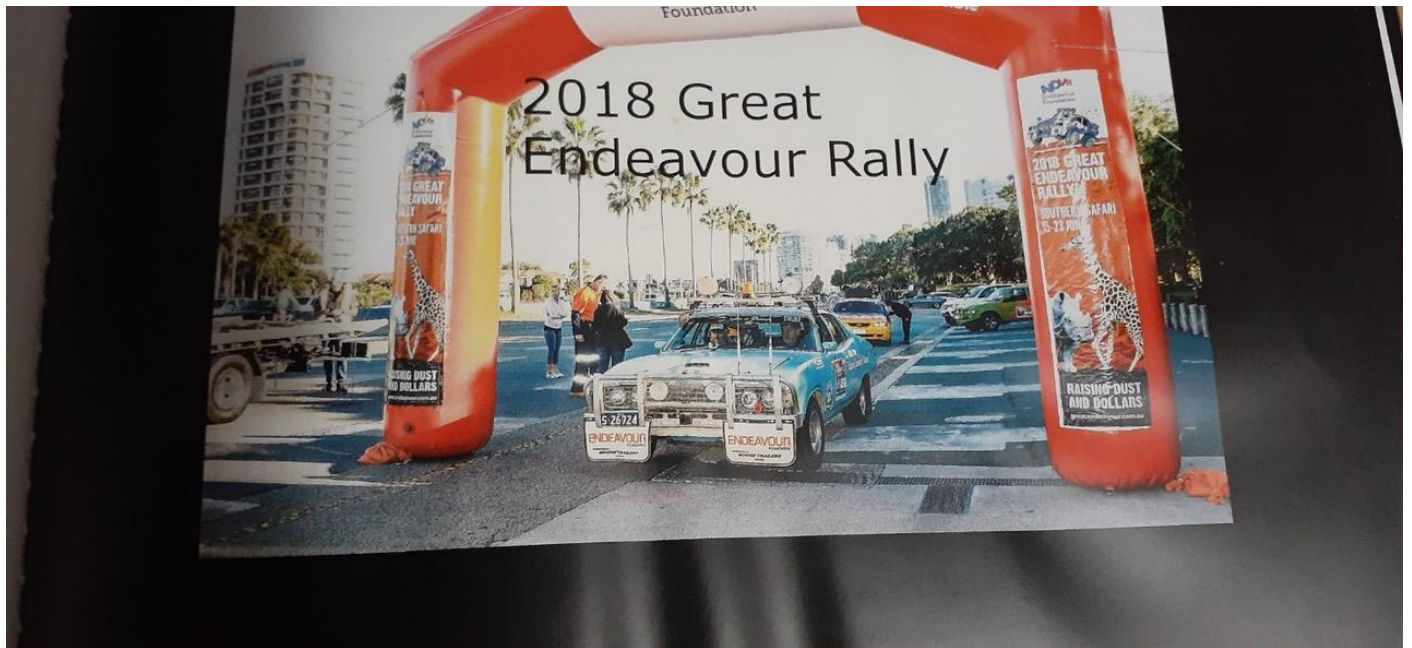

Creation of a Cruising Boat Division

The Tingira Boat Club has a structure that is able to cater for a variety of boating interests. It is not exclusively a sailing club nor a motor boat club or a paddling club. Over the years the principle activities of the Club have changed with the interests of the members of that time. Originally known as the Tingira Sailing Club, it catered at first for a small fleet of off-the-beach sailing craft. This was followed by a period of time when many members owned motor cruisers and enjoyed day trips and overnight excursions. Then came larger sailing yachts with races on week days and weekend cruising. Given the varied interests of members over time, the change of name from Tingira Sailing Club to Tingira Boat Club was indeed a great idea.

Currently the Club has members who are actively involved in off-the-beach sailing (Vagabonds), Jubilee One-Design Yachts and paddling (OC6s, OC2s, kayaks etc).

Long time Tingira member, Ray Ward, has written to the Management Committee suggesting the Club should sound-out the interest of members and the viability of a creating a cruising yacht group within the Club as he believes the population of Macleay Island has grown substantially in recent years. He is aware that a number of members own larger cruising boats but currently there are no club activities that focus on these members / boats.

Ray Ward has offered to take a serious role in assisting with the formation and coordination of a cruising group that would provide organised events, sail experience, coastal navigation, maintenance training and support for its members.

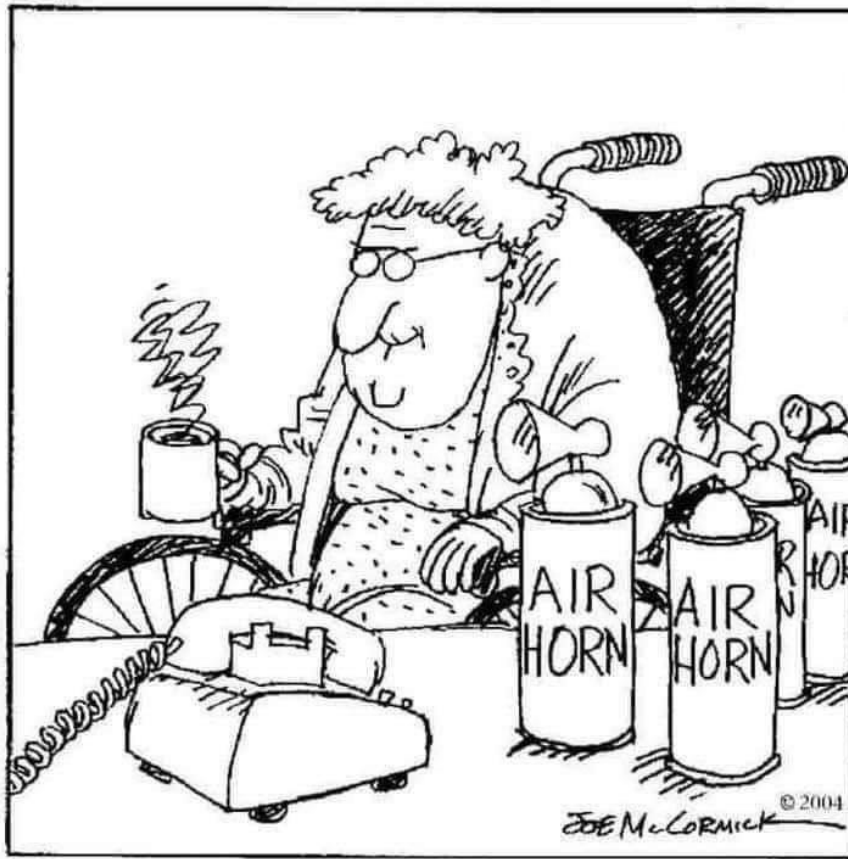
