Arrangements were made for the transfer with a team from Te Waka Dragons coming over to Tingira last Saturday in their club RIB power boat.

Peter Hayward and his team had the dragon boat ready to go, loaded with paddles, sweep oar, drum, dragon head and tail.

The dragon boat was towed back to Redland Bay where a trailer was waiting to take it on to their club headquarters in Albion.

This was a good outcome as the once idle dragon boat will now be put to good use by the members of an emerging new dragon boat club.

Meanwhile a second Tingira dragon boat has also found a new home. This time, thanks to sailing Master Ian Waller-Wilkinson, club member Don Newman has taken the other dragon boat for a special project. He is planning to convert the dragon boat into a proa (a traditional Malaysian or Indonesian outrigger sailing boat).
