Regular boat maintenance days at the Tingira clubhouse have resumed. They are held each Tuesday commencing at 9:00am.

Currently there are two projects underway:

- Recoating the interior floor of the OC6 with a non-skid blue flowcoat.
- Repainting the Club's Corsair sailing dinghy.

Last Week's Handy Tip: Bruce Legg showed us how to make a non-skid paint finish (important for decks etc) by sprinkling sugar on top of the flowcoat as is applied. After the flowcoat sets hard and the sugar dissolves with the help of some water it leaves a good grip surface that is easy to sand off for future recoating.

The group has a mixture of those who possess boatbuilding and handyman skills and those wanting to learn some - all that's required is an interest in boats. And it's not all just about work - each session begins and ends with a cuppa on the deck and a discussion on all things nautical (and a general chin wag).

Club members are welcome to drop in for a sticky beak or lend a hand (or expertise).

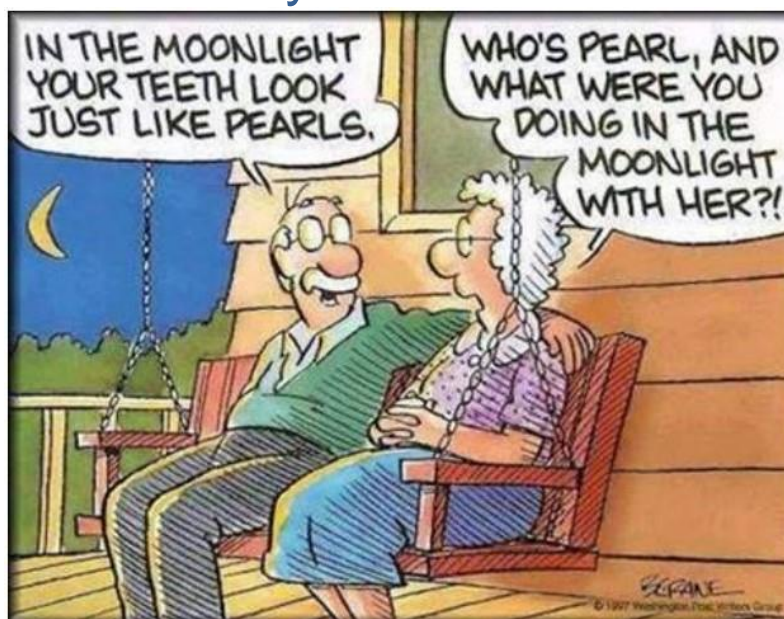
