OC6 Paddling Get-Together Planned for the May Day Weekend

Planning is now well underway for a social paddling get-together to be held at the Tingira Boat Club on Sunday 01 May. We are inviting outrigger canoe (OC6) paddlers from Coochiemudlo Island, Bayside Victoria Point and the Talobilla Waka Ama Club (Scarborough) to join our Tingira paddlers for a casual and fun day of paddling. The get-together will have an emphasis on having fun and enjoying the Southern Moreton Bay Island marine environment.

The planned events include a novel 5km paddle (dubbed the Crossover Flag Snatch) with the paddlers from Coochiemudlo crossing over in their OC6s to the Tingira Club and snatching a flag from the Tingira beach and then paddling back halfway to finish at the Club pontoon positioned halfway between both Islands. Meanwhile the Tingira teams (and other visiting teams) will cross over to Coochie, snatch a flag from their beach and finish half way back at the Pontoon. The first OC6 team to make it to the Pontoon with a snatched flag will be deemed the winners. All boats will commence the crossover with a simultaneous start. If it sounds a bit confusing there is a course map for reference at the end of this article.

Following the Crossover Flag Snatch there will be a morning recess from 10:30am – 11:00am at the Tingira Club to allow the paddlers to refuel and hydrate.

The next events will be 400m sprints around a triangular course set straight out from the Club. These will commence at about 11:15am and should be quite entertaining to watch from the shore.

The paddlers will then be invited for lunch and well earned refreshments at our normal **Sunday On the Deck** from 12:00pm. During lunch there will be a presentation of prizes and awards by our Commodore Moss Lane and Sailing Master Ian Waller-Wilkinson.

A summary of the arrangements for the day are as follows:

The Island (Macleay & Coochiemudlo) Crossover Flag Snatch (5 km approx)

8:00am: Crews meet to rig and prepare OC6s

9:00am: Muster of OC6 teams at the designated start points on Macleay and Coochiemudlo Islands.

9:30am (sharp): Simultaneous start for all teams from their designated start position on Coochiemudlo or Macleay Island. Teams cross over to the opposite island to snatch a flag and then finish at the Tingira Pontoon positioned halfway between Coochiemudlo and Macleay Island (see map).

10:30am – 11:00am: Morning Tea Break at Tingira Boat Club

Banana bread, tea, coffee and cool drinks will be available at the Tingira Clubhouse.

11:15am: OC6 Sprints (400m)

From the start line, OC6 crews paddle a triangular course (100m + 200m + 100m) marked by orange buoys in an anticlockwise direction. The sprints will take place close to the shoreline and start between a buoy set on the Tingira beach and the Club pontoon.

12:00 – 1:00pm: Lunch and presentation of a perpetual trophy and other prizes.

Burgers and salads will be available from the Club kitchen. The Club bar will be open from 12:00pm.
