Since late last year the Management Committee has been undertaking a process with the Redland City Council to renew our lease which expired in February of this year.

We received the good news late last week that a new lease has been approved by Redland City Council (Council) for Tingira Boat Club Incorporated for a standard period of 10 years.

The new lease will include an expansion of our current lease footprint (whole of lot 286 - 91 Coast Road) to include the area over part Lot 285 (93-95 Coast Road) so as to encompass the area utilised by our Club for the storage of Club's boats and canoes. This will require the Club to have a surveyor undertake a Lease Survey Plan on our behalf. Congratulations and thanks to all those who have assisted in the process of our lease renewal.
