## Happy Birthday Tingira!!

### *Proudly Celebrating 40 Years*

*“In the early days of the Tingira Boat Club it was a club for everyone - almost a Poor Man’s Club in a way - the people who started it had no money, no clubhouse, no nothing! Just an idea of a club.”*

(As recalled by Lyn Garner and recorded by Ruth Venner in 2005)

#### **And an idea that is still going strong!**

Saturday’s Annual General Meeting not only marked the beginning of the 2022–23 Club Year but the beginning of our Club’s 40<sup>th</sup> Anniversary.

According to the information on the Club’s Honour Board the first year of the Tingira Boat Club (then named the **Tingira Sailing Club**) was the 1982 – 1983 club year. Those listed as office bearers for the 1982 - 83 club year were Rick McKenzie as Commodore, Lavinia O’Brien as Secretary, and I. O’Brien as Treasurer. The first meetings of the fledging Club were held at the home of Lavinia O’Brien on Western Road, Macleay Island.

#### **The Name ‘Tingira’**

The name of the club, Tingira Sailing Club, was chosen by Lavinia O’Brien as she believed that Tingira was a local Aboriginal word meaning ‘the sea’. However, there is some disagreement over the spelling, meaning and pronunciation of the word.

One online Aboriginal word dictionary has the word **Tingara** meaning ‘the sea’. With most references in agreement that the word Tingira comes from a local Aboriginal source and denotes the sea the name is therefore very fitting for a boat club located on the shores of a Southern Moreton Bay Island.

Lyn Garner (one of the founding members) always firmly maintained that Tingira should be pronounced **“Tingrra”** with no emphasis on the second vowel.
