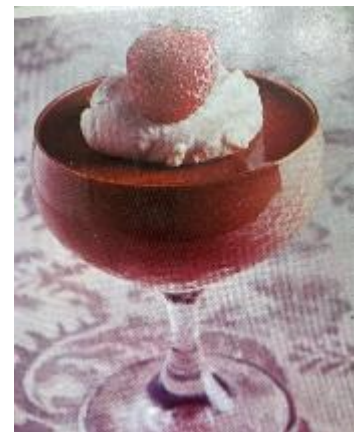

Ahoy There Tingira Boaties!

The Tingira Boat Club is a broad church in terms of boating interests. Our membership includes those with an interest in paddling (OC1s & OC6s), off-the-beach dinghy sailing, yacht sailing, power boating (both planning and displacement hulls), sail boarding, learning to sail and stand-up paddling.

Over the past two weeks I have been in contact with many of the different interest groups to plan a comprehensive boating activities calendar for the year.

So far, I have been in contact with the **Jubilee One-Design Yacht** group (through **Tony Harland**) and earmarked Saturday 30 September to Monday 02 October for the 4th Jubilees Queensland Championships to be hosted by our club. Tony has also advised us the dates for the **Point Talburpin Sailors Get Togethers**.

Trevor Rogers has volunteered to organise our off-the-beach sailing program this year and includes our Vagabond sailing and Start Sailing program. Trevor is keen to assist in maximising the use of our Vagabonds and having regular off-the-beach sailing at the Club.

I have met with **Karen Smith** and **Kerry Otter** to devise **OC6 Paddling** program and times for the year. They are keen to follow up last year's successful OC6 regatta with the **OC6 Tingira Cup** and have earmarked Sunday 07 May for the event. Their paddling times for February - June have been completed and are now published in this newsletter.

I have also met with Marion Mori and Ted Upton to discuss a casual (or come and try) paddling group. Session times will be published when they come to hand.

Our Club Secretary **Jim Smith** along with **John Hynes**, **Peter Lawson** and **Paul Hollingdale** met recently to form a Power Boat group within the Club. There is a strong demand for such a group, with many newcomers wanting to become more familiar with boating in our beautiful bay waters and having the added support of doing it in group of likeminded boaties

Paul Hollingdale with a long involvement with Volunteer Marine Rescue groups has volunteered to assist with the development of safety management systems for our Club's safety boats.
