Last Saturday morning at our club rooms, Chris Marshall from Coast Guard Redland Bay and our very own Paul Hollingdale from VMR, provided a wonderfully informative presentation on all aspects of Marine and boating safety, including local waterway navigation and marine beacon recognition. 20 + Members attended, and all agreed it was a great way to refresh and enhance our onboard safety and basic navigational skills, plus update all emergency numbers and VHF radio channels.

Both Chris and Paul informed the group of the impending Federal and State government move to join both Volunteer Coast Guard and Volunteer Marine Rescue into the one entity called "Marine Rescue". The integration is scheduled to commence over the next few months and will be gradually rolled out over the next few years. They explained that there will be no change to what and how assistance is provided to the boating public, and will be "business as usual" as far as operational procedures go.

On behalf of the Tingira Boat Club, we extend our thanks to both Chris and Paul for providing us with such an informative presentation.

We have begun work on our next Boating work-shop event, organising a VHF Radio Licence day. Stay tuned
