Price Increase for Friday Night Members Dinners

At the last Management Meeting the committee carefully dissected the income and expenditure relating to Friday Night Members' dinners. The profit margin we strive towards is 50% overall. The cost of food is not an exact science so we base this profit as an average over all Friday Night meals. Sadly, with the sudden and steep increase in the cost of food items, reported just a few weeks ago as currently running at 19%, we have had little choice but to increase the price of Friday Night meals to \$15.00 for members and \$18.00 for non-members. Our profit margin from meals and the bar are vital to the continuing viability of running our club. These funds are needed to pay for electricity, insurance, registrations and the maintenance and improvements around the clubhouse, to name just a few.

The price increase will commence at our next Members Dinner on Friday 5th May. As this is the first Friday of the month it will be Fish and Chips with salad and mushy peas. Fine British fare on the eve of the Coronation of King Charles III.
