Junior sailor, Teasha Souter, showed lots of enthusiasm and did a great job on the tiller, steering her way around the course and at the same time receiving valuable sailing advice from experienced sailor Don Newman.

It was a pleasure to see Jacqueline Hope back from overseas and sailing again at the Club. She also shared her sailing knowledge and experience with her crew Jennifer Ng and Louise Gallard.

Mike King took his Jubilee yacht, 'Nereid', out for a sail and generously gave PJ Smith and Mike Hatfield time on the tiller.

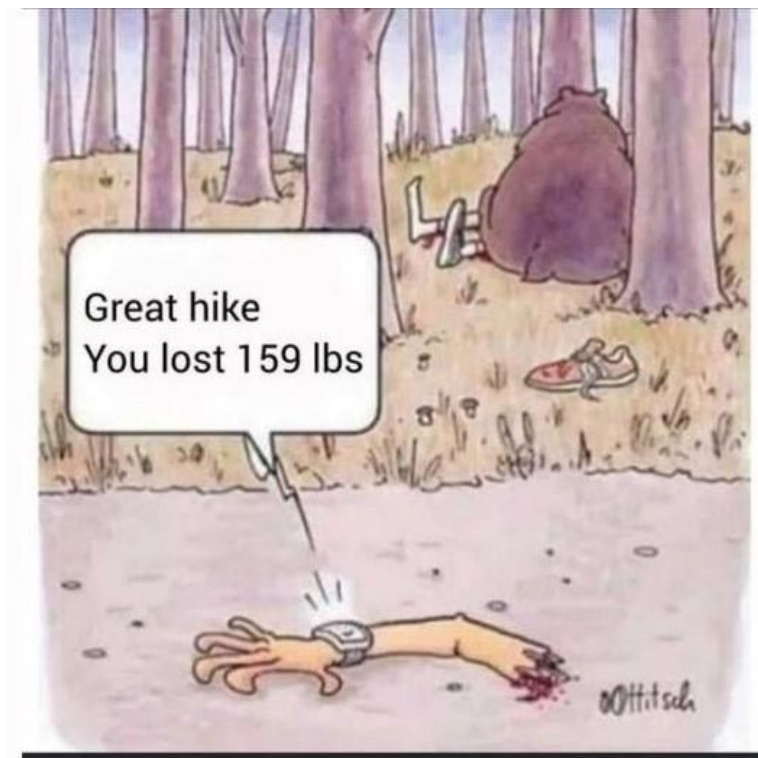
