VHF Radio course:



The Motor-boat group section of our Boat Club is currently organising a **VHF Radio Course** to be held in our club rooms in the coming weeks.

The radio course is called "An Australian Waters Qualification" (AWO) and enables you to use the qualification to apply via AMSA for a MMSI number should you require it.

It allows you to use a VHF radio in Australian waters within 12 NM of the coastline.

The course takes approx 4 Hours to complete and will cost \$70.00 per person.

We need to have at least **10 people** to commit to the course to enable it to be run here at our club rooms on the island.


Two newbies made their Vagabond sailing debut. **Leanne Bruce** sailed with Peter Fox and **Terry Hegarty** sailed with Don Newman.
