VHF Radio course: Last Call



The Motor-boat group section of our Boat Club is currently organising a **VHF Radio Course** to be held in our club rooms in the coming weeks.

The radio course is called "An Australian Waters Qualification" (AWO) and enables you to use the qualification to apply via AMSA for a MMSI number should you require it.

It allows you to use a VHF radio in Australian waters within 12 NM of the coastline.

The course takes approx 4 Hours to complete and will cost \$70.00 per person.

We now have 10 members committed to the course and will be setting the Course date in the next week.
