Tickets are limited, so don't get caught short. Get in and book early.

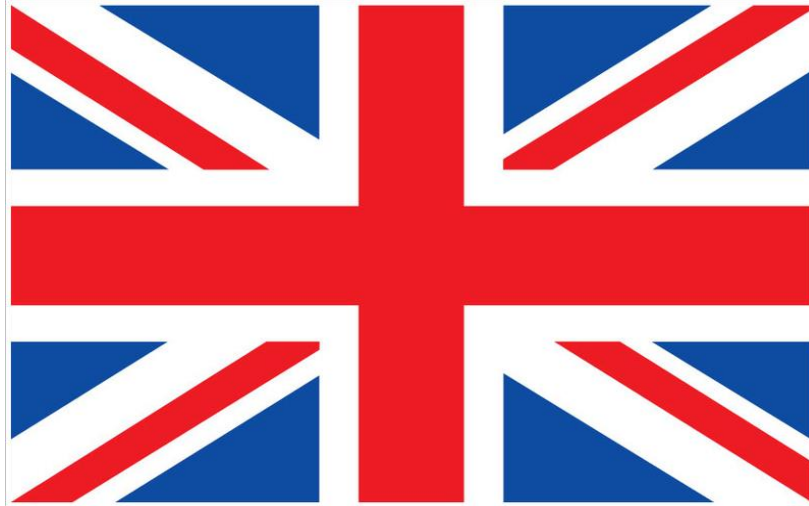
