The Calvert Memorial Event for Vagabond Sailing Dinghies is scheduled for **Sunday 26 November** and will comprise of 3 races. The event is open to all Vagabond class sailing boats. The Club's Vagabonds will be allocated to eligible skippers at the discretion of the Tingira Sailing Committee.

The program and race times scheduled below are approximate.
(Note: We intend to commence following races 5 minutes after the finish of the last boat in the previous race.)

8:00am Rigging yard and sheds opened

8:30am Welcome and Briefing

9:00am (approx) Race 1 (Time of first warning signal)

9:30am (approx) Race 2 (Time of first warning signal)

10:00am (approx) Race 3 (Time of first warning signal)

10:30am (approx) Completion of racing followed by refreshments at the Tingira Clubhouse.

The courses shall be a windward and return 'sausage' course which will be set just west of the Clubhouse and similar to the one used in the recent Jubilee Championships. This will give the opportunity for interested spectators to view much of the race from the Clubhouse shore.

The series will be conducted using the low score system and a boat's final score will be the total of her race scores.

The Calvert Memorial Trophy will be awarded to the boat that gains the least number of points in the series.

Individual prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places.

Trophies and awards will be presented at the Tingira Boat Club on **Sunday 10 December from 12:00pm.**

NOTICE OF RACE

1. The sailing event will be governed by the *Racing Rules of Sailing* current on the race date (published by Australia Sailing) and by the Sailing Instructions.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The event is open to all Vagabond class sailing boats.

Inquiries or entries from interested skippers are welcome by contacting Peter Fox by email pfox54@bigpond.com or mobile 0417 841 009 as soon as possible. The Club Vagabonds will be allocated to eligible skippers at the discretion of the Tingira Sailing Committee.

3. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

The race times scheduled below are **approximate**. It is intended to commence following races 5 minutes after the finish of the last boat in the previous race.

Sunday 26 November

8:30am Welcome and Briefing

9:00am (approx) **Race 1** (Time of first Warning Signal)

9:30am (approx) **Race 2** (Time of first Warning Signal)

10:00am (approx) **Race 3** (Time of first Warning Signal)

10:30am (approx) Completion of racing followed by refreshments at the Tingira Clubhouse.

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be emailed to participating Vagabond skippers or may be collected from the Clubhouse on **Sunday 26 November** prior to the event briefing.

5. EVENT SITE & RACING AREA

The racing area will be a designated area west of the Tingira Boat Clubhouse, Macleay Island.

6. COURSES

The courses shall be windward and return ('sausage' course), as described in the Sailing Instructions.

7. PENALTY SYSTEM

Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turn Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

8. SCORING

Scores will be based on the accumulative scratch placings for each race and use the low score system (1st place = 1 Point). Boats that do not start, finish, retire or are disqualified are scored one more point than the total entrants of the series.

If conditions prevent the completion of the three scheduled races only one race will be required to decide the event.

A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

9. PRIZES and PRESENTATIONS

9.1 *The Calvert Memorial Trophy* will be awarded for the boat that gains the least number of points in the series (using the low score system).

9.2 Individual prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places overall.

9.3 Trophies and awards will be presented by the Tingira Boat Club on Sunday 10 December commencing from 12:00pm (approx).
