Vagabond Sailing Report - Sunday 10 December

Our last sailing day for 2023 saw a good roll-up of 7 Vagabonds. The weather gods blessed us with a fluctuating 10 - 13 knot NNE - E breeze.

It was amazing to see how much we have all improved over the year with our racing skills. Very close and exciting racing was the feature of the day.

The first race saw Bruce Legg (fresh from his return from WA) leading the



fleet in *Lego* (Vagabond 10) with Peter and Moya in "Jocelyn" (Vagabond 9) close behind. Unfortunately for Bruce his rudder broke at the pintle as he rounded the last mark before heading to the finish line allowing Peter and Moya to steal a win. Sebastian (our Junior Sailor of the Year) and Bevan Conole in Vagabond 5 sailed their best race of the day to finish in 3rd place.

In the second race Trevor and Jenny Rogers in "Penny" led the fleet home with Pete and Moya in *Jocelyn* in second place and Ian Waller-Wilkinson and Rob Verruso in **Orion** (Vagabond 4) finishing well in 3rd place.

The third race saw the fleet sailing very close together with Trevor and Jenny Rogers in the lead again. Mike King in Vagabond 3 showed great upwind sailing and tactics to storm home to take second place.

3 Million Cheers go to **Don Newman** who sailed with Leanne Bruce and Terry Hegarty and despite having the additional crew aboard sailed very competitively.

Overall place results over the 3 races:

- 2. Peter and Moya in *Jocelyn* (1st, 2nd, 3rd) with 6 points.

- **4.** Mike King with a new junior sailor in Vagabond 3 (5th, 4th, 2nd) with 11 points.
- **5.** Sebastian and Bevan Conole in Vagabond 5 (3rd, 6th, 5th) with 14 points.
- **6.** Don Newman, Leanne Bruce and Terry Hegarty in Vagabond 2 (6th, 5th, 6th) 17 points
- 7. Bruce Legg in Lego unfortunately retired due to a broken rudder.

A big thankyou to the crew on the Pontoon. Chrissy Carrick, Maree Lallensack, Jenny Rush and Moss did a great job with the starts, finishes and records. Big thankyou also to PJ Smith and Moss who crewed the safety rib "Sandpiper".

Following the race it was back to the Tingira Clubhouse for a morning tea of scones, jam and cream and other delights, and then the presentation of sailing awards for 2023.

There will be a break from sailing at Tingira during the Christmas - New Year period, but we are all looking forward to a return in 2024.

What a great advertisement for our club with our sailing team, headed by our ever-dependable Sailing Master Peter Fox showing off the joy and excitement of competitive sailing.




