Vagabond Sailing Report and News

The Calvert Memorial Sailing Event for Vagabond Sailing Dinghies was conducted on Sunday 26 November.

A record of 8 club Vagabond dinghies participated in the event which consisted of 3 short races. A light NNW breeze prevailed and made for very close and competitive sailing. Racing was so close (and at times intense) that any mistake in tactics came at a dear price. Place positions changed constantly during each race with only narrow margins separating boats at the finish line.

The start / finish crew on the Pontoon, led by Chrissy Carrick and assisted by her crew of volunteers, were kept extremely busy with starting, finishing and recording the places and times of the 8 boats over the three races. A very big thankyou to them. Peter Lawson and Norm Black did a marvellous job in *"Sandpiper"* of setting the buoys for the course and keeping an eye on the welfare and safety of our sailors.

- The son and father team of Sebastian and Bevan Conole won the first race with Mike King and Leanne Bruce, sailing in Vagabond 3, coming close behind in 2nd place.
- In race 2, Trevor and Jenny Rogers in *Penny* led the fleet home with Don Newman and Wesley Greaver sailing in Vagabond 2 finished in 2nd place.
- The third race saw Trevor and Jenny nail a 1st place again with Sebastian and Bevan gaining 2nd place.

Points were awarded for each race using the low point scoring system with the following overall results for this year's Calvert Memorial:

1st Place Trevor and Jenny Rogers sailing in *Penny* (Vagabond 1) with 5 Points

2nd Place Sebastian and Bevan Conole sailing in Vagabond 5 with 9 Points (on count back)

3rd Place Mike King and Leanne Bruce sailing in Vagabond 3 with 9 points (on count back)

Sunday Sailing, Morning Tea and Annual Presentation of Trophies - Sunday 10 December

The last sailing day of the year for our Vagabond sailors is scheduled for this Sunday 10 December.

An early morning high tide of 2.35m at 8:01am will mean an early morning start:

7:30am Shed and boat yard open for boat rigging

8:30am Briefing for all sailors, pontoon and safety boat crews

9:15am (approx) Start of Race 1

10:30am (approx) Completion of racing and return to the Club

11:00am After sailing there will be an end of year Morning Tea and **Presentation of Awards** for our off-the-beach sailors and will include:

- Club Championships (based on aggregate points) for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places.
- Calvert Memorial Sailing Event Trophy for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places
- Tingira Junior Sailor of the Year Award
- Carolyn Hoernel Memorial Trophy Female Sailor of the Year
