

Start Sailing Program Commences for 2024

This year we have had an increased number of Club members expressing an interest in learning to sail and a good number of inquiries from Island based parents looking for sailing lessons for their teenage children. Over the years the Tingira Boat Club has conducted learn to sail lessons. More recently the *Start Sailing Program* was devised to introduce newbies (both young and old) to the basics of how to sail an off-the-beach sailboat.

The program utilises our Club's fleet of Vagabond sailing boats and the assistance of some of our more experienced dinghy sailors. Due to the high demand the first session of the program commenced last week on Saturday 10 February.

The introductory session focused on the following discussion topics:

- What to check beforehand. (e.g. weather and tides)
- Personal protection from the sun, wind, water, heat and cold.
- Personal and group safety.
- What to take in the boat.

We then had a session on the water with participants sharing the tasks of helming the dinghy while under paddle power.

Despite grey skies the newbies showed a great deal of enthusiasm and interest. A big thankyou to the sizeable group of experienced sailors who came along to share their sailing skills. A big thankyou (and 3 million cheers) to Trevor Rogers, Ian Waller-Wilkinson, Bruce Legg and Don Newman.

Start Sailing Program - Sunday 18 February 2024

There was a very pleasing attendance of beginner sailors at our *Start Sailing* session held this Sunday at the Tingira Boat Club.

Just as pleasing was the corresponding number of experienced sailors volunteering their time to share their knowledge with the beginners.

After a quick recap of the session conducted last week we got down to learning to tie those important knots used for rigging a sailboat.

Trevor Rogers introduced the 'stopper knot', the 'round turn & two half hitches' and the all important and very useful 'bowline' knot,

Our volunteer instructors then gave one-on-one assistance to help our newbies master the art of tying the knots.

Next the beginner sailors were shown how to rig the Vagabond sailboats ready for a sail.

Jibs and mainsails were hoisted by their halliards (not called ropes) and their sheets (not to the hull. There was lots of sailor's 'talk' and be called ropes either) and were connected to interesting boat names given for all the bits.





Again big thanks to our experienced Vagabond sailors for volunteering their time and sharing their knowledge and skills.

From the feedback on the night, it was a great concept and everyone agreed one that should be repeated. (Especially the Drumstick Dessert)


A very special mention and a big thank you to Nigel Sanderson and Kevin McMath who jumped in and did
