The breeze was very light and the sea very flat but there was just enough breeze to fill the sails and have the boats moving along. It actually made for good conditions for those learning to sail.

Our junior skipper **Seb Conole** took junior members **James Henry** and **Issac Monaghan** out in his boat and judging by the laughter coming from the boat, they all enjoyed their time.

The mother and daughter team of **Amy** and **Olive Henry** sailed with **Trevor Rogers** who shared his experience and knowledge in how to sail in the light conditions.
